Install and update

For an update, it is recommended to delete any previous directory of Toulouse.

Unzip and move the directory "Toulouse" in "Custom Scenery" of X-plane and uncheck "Allow slopped runways" in Rendering options.

Be aware, this scenery uses OpenSceneryX and you have to install it by clicking on this image :



Then, you can launch Xplane and put your aircraft at Toulouse-Montaudou (LFBO), or Lasbordes (LFCL), or Bourgnon Saint Bernard (LFIT) or Muret L'Herm (LFBR) and enjoy it...

How to use Marginal's Autogates

Blagnac's Gate (LFBO) are animated by Marginal's plugin which you can download [here](#).

Read the ReadMe.txt in the package to know how to install it.
